FAQs

What is the Indie Author Project?

The Indie Author Project (IAP) is a publishing community that includes public libraries, authors, curators, and readers working together to connect library patrons with great indie-published books. IAP includes annual contests and a year-round discovery program designed to help indie authors reach more readers through the library, both locally and potentially all across the U.S. and Canada.

What counts as being an indie-published author?

The Indie Author Project considers indie-published authors to include any authors who have the rights to independently sell, market, and distribute their works, including authors who have fully self-published all of their works, as well as hybrid authors who may have the rights to some of their works and be under contract on others. If you have any questions or concerns about your eligibility for the Indie Author Project, please let us know.

What are the Indie Author Project Select collections?

In addition to being available through participating libraries on BiblioBoard Library, books that are chosen by our curators can opt into a royalty-paying program, where your eBook is sold in curated collections via library eBook platforms such as OverDrive, DPLA Exchange, cloudLibrary, and Axis360. The program is only available to authors who are part of our curated collections.

Does the Indie Author Project cost anything?

It is completely free and non-exclusive for authors to participate in the Indie Author Project collections and contests.
