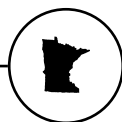




## WE'RE LOOKING FOR THE BEST COMMUNITY-CREATED BOOKS IN MINNESOTA



**This year's contest kicks off on April 1, 2022**, and submissions will be accepted through May 31, 2022.

### **Prizes and Eligibility include:**

#### **Each winning organization will receive:**

- \$2,000 cash prize
- Honors at the 2022 Minnesota Library Conference
- Honorary plaque
- Printing of the winning works
- Opportunity to have the winning works available throughout the state in the Indie Minnesota collection on BiblioBoard Library
- Media promotion throughout Minnesota

#### **Each work that is submitted to the contest must be:**

- Created by a Minnesota-based organization
  - Nonprofits, libraries, schools, writers groups, historical societies, etc. are all eligible
  - One member may submit on behalf of their organization
- A **recommended** minimum length of 10,000 words or 20 pages
- Available in either ePUB (**strongly encouraged**) or PDF format

*In addition to being evaluated on quality, judges will also consider the role libraries have played in supporting the organization or the creation of the work being submitted.*
